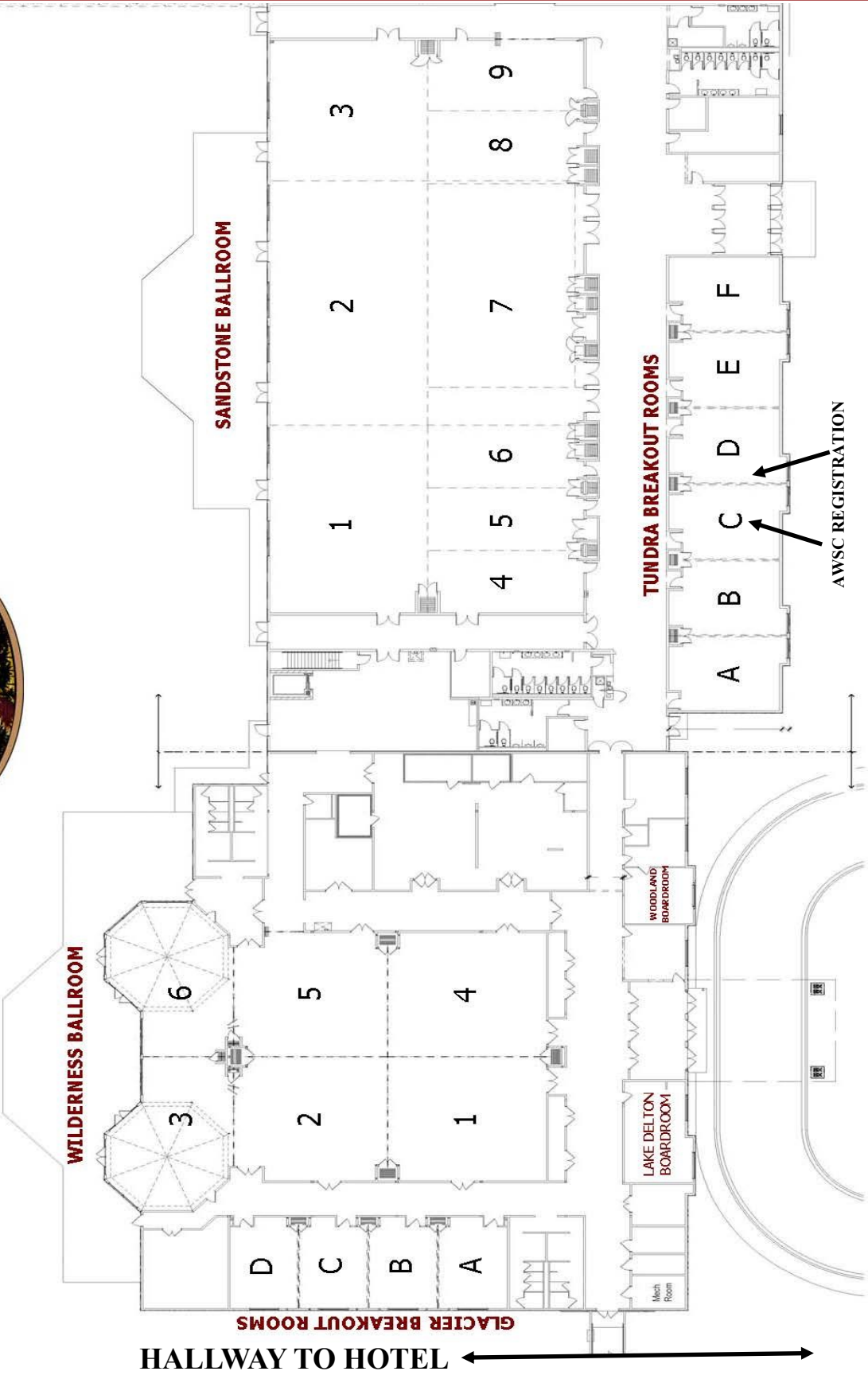

Snowmobile Friendly Community Awards

SFC Award Celebrates Snowmobile Club and Community Partnership

The Association of Wisconsin Snowmobile Clubs (AWSC) formally announces Wisconsin Communities as a “Snowmobile Friendly Community.” The AWSC normally announces the Snowmobile Friendly Community Awards during their annual spring Convention, but COVID-19 forced a cancellation of this state-wide Convention for over 600 snowmobilers representing all 72 Wisconsin counties for the years of 2020 and 2021.

Congratulations are in order for these communities. They achieved their Snowmobile Friendly status by working with their Snowmobile Club to complete a 21-page application describing how they and their Snowmobile Club advocate for safe and responsible snowmobiling in their area. All SFC winners are awarded reflective, high-visibility, 24” x 36” highway signs to let all visitors know they are entering a “Snowmobile Friendly Community.”

Created through a partnership between the AWSC and the Wisconsin Department of Tourism, a statewide Evaluation Panel includes a Tourism professional to ensure the Program accurately identifies which communities and snowmobile clubs are “best” at welcoming, preserving, and providing snowmobile access, support, and services for snowmobilers. The Snowmobile Friendly Community Award/Designation is a four-year term and communities may reapply for subsequent awards.

2020 Of The Year Awardees

Ron Salter—AWSC 2020 Snowmobiler Of The Year

Ron is a member of the Back 40 Trail Riders and Weyerhaeuser Snowmobile Club. He has been active in snowmobiling since 1966 (54 years). Ron is very active in his club working with the landowners and fund raising.

Alysha “AJ” Kreager—AWSC 2020 Young Snowmobiler Of The Year

AJ is a member of Wisconsin Valley Sno Jets, Trailmates Snowmobile Club, Glandon Snow Barons and the New Tom Sno Fleas. AJ has been involved in snowmobiling since 2005. She is very involved in snowmobiling from serving as AWSC KAOS secretary to brushing and marking trails. In addition to that, every fall/winter AJ reaches out to all the snowmobile clubs having snowmobile safety classes in Central and Northern Wisconsin to promote youth involvement. She has spoken to over 600 new youth in the past 2 years.

Edward & Bonnie Pollich Family— AWSC 2020 Snowmobile Family Of The Year

The Pollich Family belongs to the Snobirds Snowmobile Club. They represent 4 generations of memberships in snowmobiling in one family. First Bonnie’s parents were members. Both held offices in the club. Her mother served as Secretary/Treasurer, and both were Mr & Mrs. Santa Claus for many years. Then came along Bonnie and Ed. Ed was groomer operator and coordinator/mechanic and trail chairman. Since he has been on the Board of Directors headed many snowmobile trips, co-chair on highway clean-up projects and trail up keep projects. Bonnie headed up many food committees including the clubs major fund raisers. All this followed by their children, where currently one daughter serves as treasurer and now the grandchildren are all involved in many club projects the club has to help further the great sport of snowmobiling.

Norbert Van De Hei—AWSC 2020 Volunteer Groomer Of The Year

Norb is a member of the Denmark Norseman. He has been a dedicated groomer for almost 50 years. Norb has trained new operators for grooming over the years. When he first started, bed springs with concrete blocks were used for grooming. He has helped brush, maintain and mark trails. Norb has been a trail boss for many years in our Brown County Section. Ken's Sports—AWSC 2020 Dealer Of The Year

Ken's Sports is a member of four local area snowmobile clubs. At times they have been members of as many as 8 clubs. Ken's Sports has been an active dealership in snowmobiling for 53 years and counting (since 1968, one family—Ken and Mary Vander Loop) Throughout the years, Ken Vander Loop has been an active blue member and club volunteer for trail work and has helped groom trails. They are a long time AWSC Commercial Sponsor. In 2019 they established and donated four, \$300 AWSC Scholarships: Ken's Sports academic Excellence Awards to the AWSC Scholarship Fund. Ken's Sports supports multiple clubs by keeping a stock of trail maps on site. Tom Lubich—AWSC 2021 Snowmobiler Of The Year

Tom joined the Prescott Sno-Bees in 1999 and is still a current member. Tom began snowmobiling at a young age and fell in love with the sport in his teenage years during the early 1970's. Tom has served 12 plus years as an officer in his club. He has been on the board of directors for the Prescott Sno-Bees for over 19 years. In 2009 Tom became Pierce County Director until retiring in 2019. Since joining the Sno-Bees, Tom has volunteered and organized many events over the years.

Rome Sno-Bandits—AWSC 2021 Club of The Year

The Rome Sno-Bandits, Nekoosa, WI The club has a total of 325 members, 114 AWSC family memberships, 53 AWSC single memberships, 23 AWSC commercial sponsors and 21 secondary members. The club has been active for over 50 years. The Rome Sno-Bandits Snowmobile Club started in the late 1960's when about eight couples from the Rome area decided to form a club. They called themselves the Bentley Hillbillies Snowmobile Club. As the sport and the club grew, it was decided to change the name of the club to the Rome Sno-Bandits. On March 9th, 1978, the club was granted incorporation as the Rome Sno-Bandits by the State of Wisconsin. The Rome Sno-Bandits groom 35 miles of funded and non-funded trails in Northern Adams County and Southern Wood County. We obtained an additional 10 miles of trails in 2008 when a neighboring club in Southern Wood County disbanded. The club has eight volunteer groomer operators that keep our trails in prime riding condition. The club is fortunate to have many members that are active in our local community as well as at the county, state and national levels. These active members bring back important information to keep our club members informed of critical issues at all levels of snowmobiling. The club has numerous fundraisers throughout the year. They have many local partnerships and are involved in activities, regionally, statewide and nationally.

Track Side—AWSC 2021 Dealer Of The Year

The dealership is active in clubs in Vilas, Oneida and Iron counties, to include Upper Michigan in Watersmeet, MI. They are under new management since 2018, Track Side has been involved in organized snowmobiling since the early 1980's. Track Side sponsors track ads during World Champion Snowmobile Derby and all AM-SOIL SnoCross National Races at WCDC in Eagle River. They provide donations for local clubs for all fundraising events. The business is located on a snowmobile trail which is located across from the derby track. Track Side sponsors safety classes by providing snowmobiles for participants to complete practical (hands-on) portion of class. Track Side offers a "Loyalty Rewards and Never Down Plan" for customers to become eligible to use a "never down" unit when their machines is in for service longer than 2 days. This program also partners with additional local businesses to receive additional discounts.
