### **AWSC Committee Explanations**

#### **EXPLANATION OF AWSC COMMITTEES**

According to AWSC Bylaws Article III Section 7, The President may designate one or more committees of the Board of Directors to assist in the conduct of the affairs of the corporation. Article II Section 8 references Roberts Rules in Plain English.

In accordance with Robert's Rules, Committee assignments are ultimately made by the President of the organization. Operationally, assignments are made by coordinating the desires of the individuals (as stated in their Bio sheets) with the desires of the respective Committee Chairs. We look to the Committees to determine who their Chair will be. In the absence of that direction, the President and the Executive Board can help determine the most suitable candidate to Chair a Committee.

**AUDIT** – The Audit Committee usually meets at the AWSC office prior to each Directors meeting to review AWSC bills and payments. At times they may make an office procedure recommendation regarding bills and payments to the Executive Board.

**ENVIRONMENTAL/BYLAWS & CREDENTIALS** – This Committee is in charge of changes to the AWSC bylaws and conducts the annual election of AWSC officers, as well as a monitoring group who keeps an eye on conditions that affect land use and access not only in Wisconsin but all across the country.

**EXECUTIVE/FINANCE** – The Officers of the AWSC make up the Executive and Finance Committee. This Committee oversees and coordinates the activities of the Association, oversees the budgeting process, and approves Association expenditures.

**FUND RAISING** – This Committee is responsible for seeking out additional funding through organizing events, (raffles, silent auction, etc...).

**INSURANCE** – This Committee reviews various snowmobile insurance opportunities for clubs and reviews Wisconsin Workers Compensation requirements. This Committee also seeks answers concerning liability issues.

**LEGISLATIVE**– The Legislative Committee reviews or recommends legislation and works jointly with other committees and the Governors Snowmobile Recreation Council in reviewing legislative proposals. This committee does meet occasionally in the office of the AWSC Attorney/Lobbyist.

**MAGAZINE**– This Committee reviews and proofs each issue of the Wisconsin Snowmobile News (WSN) and suggests changes and ways to improve the magazine that would make it more appealing and useful to AWSC members.

**MEMBERSHIP**– This Committee promotes membership of the AWSC. This Committee also selects the AWSC Snowmobiler, Snowmobile Family and Young Snowmobiler of the Year.

**MULTI TRAILS/SURFACING** – This Committee is the watchdog for any multi trail purposes.

### AWSC Committee Explanations - cont'd

**NOMINATING** – This committee is made up of three Directors/Past Presidents appointed each year to search for eligible members willing to run for AWSC Officer Positions (President, Vice President, Secretary and Treasurer). They will ensure we have capable and qualified candidates to vote for at the Annual Meeting.

**PUBLICITY/PROMOTION**– This Committee promotes snowmobiling related activities and works jointly with other Committees. Examples are: Safe snowmobiling, AWSC 25 year activity, membership. This committee is responsible for the AWSC Trailer and schedule (listed on the AWSC web site). This Committee also selects the AWSC Dealer of the Year. (Reference to History removed to be considered as separate Committee)

**SAFETY AND EDUCATION** – This Committee reviews and recommends programs for safety education and reviews law enforcement efforts.

**SCHOLARSHIP**— This Committee is responsible for the selection of scholarship recipients from applications to receive the designated scholarships.

**SNOWFLAKE-** This committee is responsible for the coordination and organization of the Miss Snowflake pageant.

**TRAILS** – This committee reviews legislation pertaining to trail funding, makes recommendations for signing and suggests grooming and manpower rates. This Committee also selects the winner of the AWSC Groomer of the Year.

**YOUTH** – This committee is responsible for getting the youth involved in a variety of ways. These young members are the future leaders of the AWSC.

**VINTAGE/HISTORY** – This committee is responsible for snowmobiling history for the AWSC and the vintage snowmobiles. This Committee also selects the winner of the AWSC Club of the Year.

VIP RIDE - This committee is responsible for organizing the yearly ride.



These communities achieved their Snowmobile Friendly status by working with their Snowmobile Club to complete a 21-page application describing how they and their Snowmobile Club advocate for safe and responsible snowmobiling in their area. All SFC winners are awarded reflective, high-visibility, 24" x 36" highway signs to let all visitors know they are entering a "Snowmobile Friendly Community."

Created through a partnership between the AWSC and the Wisconsin Department of Tourism, a statewide Evaluation Panel includes a Tourism professional to ensure the Program accurately identifies which communities and snowmobile clubs are "best" at welcoming, preserving, and providing snowmobile access, support, and services for snowmobilers. The Snowmobile Friendly Community Award/Designation is a four-year term and communities may reapply for subsequent awards.

Although cancelled by the pandemic, the AWSC's Spring Convention serves as the final major snowmobiling event for the 610+ Wisconsin Snowmobile Clubs who create and maintain over 24,000 miles of public snowmobile trails connecting all 72 Wisconsin counties.
