At this year's AWSC Convention in Sheboygan County, there will be 4 bus trip options. All 4 buses

Will start with a trip to the Road America racetrack. Weather permitting, all buses will do a "hot lap" around the 5-mile course. All buses will have a guide from Road America to point out points of interest. The visit to the track will include a visit to the Paddock Club (a gift shop) and the winners circle.

A bus will be sponsored by United Snow Byrds, Beechwood Night Fliers, Cascade Apollo Riders, Adell Yetis, New Fane Kettle Riders, Five Corners S.C., and Batavia Hill & Gully Riders will have a theme entitled "A Taste of Southern Sheboygan County". This trip will include stops at Solu Estate Winery & Meadery, cheese tasting at Jersey Valley Cheese, and grooming equipment at the Town of Scott Community Center. A variety of raffles and Exciting Snowmobile Racing will be featured. The lunch menu will be AYCE walking taco/nachos (chicken and beef) with all the fixings.

A bus sponsored by the Greenbush Kettle Moraine Trailblazers, will go to the gateway to the Kettle Moraine State Forest, Glenbulah for a stop at Fudgienuckles Family Sport Bar for lunch. This will be followed by a drive past the Old Wade House Historical Site (an old stagecoach stop) followed by a stop at the Wesley W. Jung Carriage Museum. Next on the tour is the Sheboygan County Broughton Marsh Park and campground. For those ambitious hikers you can climb the tower for a view of the 14,000 acres of marshland. If you prefer not to climb you can see the same view via video camera inside the Marsh Lodge (and bar).

A bus sponsored by the Howards Grove Driftbusters S.C. will host a bus entitled "Snowmobiling Sheboygan Style (brat bus)". Lunch at Butch & Anne's will feature Johnsonville brats on Sheboygan's famous City Bakery hard rolls. Enjoy a Sheboygan Old Fashion at a drive thru at Bummy's in Howards Grove, followed by a visit to Rustic Rhine Saloon. This bus will feature a traditional poker run, mini bowling, corn hole, bar dice, and plenty of cash and bucket raffles.

A bus hosted by the Louis Corners S.C. of Manitowoc County .Their theme is "Grip it and Rip it with Louis Corners Bus and Brew Cruise" an afternoon fun King Louie Style. The second stop will be Switch Gear Brewing Company, in Elkhart Lake for lunch. Lunch will be pulled pork and beef sandwiches, chips, cole slaw, pickles and dessert. The third stop will be Conrads's 2nd Knot – home of King Louie and the Sn-Birds. The last stop will be the Gravel Pit Sports Bar (a trail sponsor.
